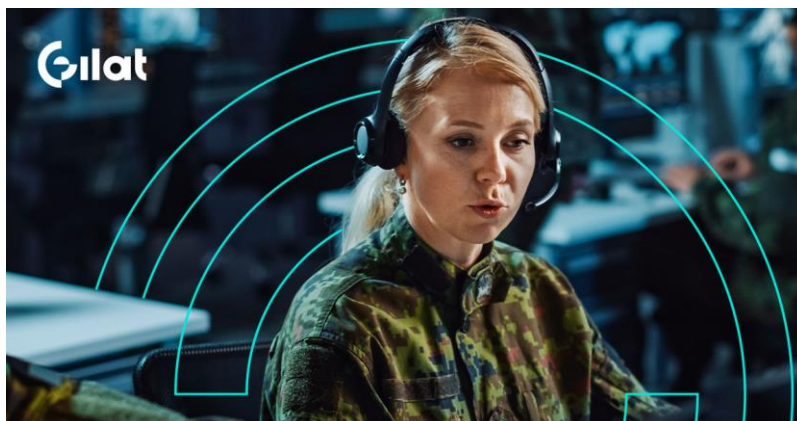


Gilat Satellite Networks Awarded Over \$5M in Support of the US Department of Defense
